Registration and Information Services:

Passport and Visa:

If in doubt, information can be obtained from the nearest Turkish Embassy or Consulate. Please click here to obtain visa information for foreigners. Most visitor visas are obtainable for a fee on arrival at the airport, but it is advisable to check in sufficient time before departure. Please check with your travel agent whether you require an entry visa to Turkey.

Time Zone:

Time is two hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT +2) in Turkey.

Telephones:

Pay phones are available at the congress venue as well as in the city. Phone cards are widely available in shops. The international dialing code for Turkey is 90, and 216 for Istanbul Asian side, 212 for European side.

Driving License:

International driving licenses are recognized throughout Turkey. Car rental companies ask for a valid driving license and sometimes 3 years of driving experience.

Credit Cards:

All major credit cards (Visa, Master Card) are accepted in Turkey by restaurants, hotels, shops and at the course registration desks.
